Visitation Guidance

In consideration of potential impact of nosocomial and severe infections within hospital wards, the partial limitation on visitation is still in place. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Visiting hours: 13:00 - 20:00 (on both weekdays and holidays)

- Limited to once per day, 30 minutes per visit, and 3 visitors (maximum)
- Wearing of a non-woven mask and hand antisepsis

 before entry are required

<Pre><Pre>cautions for visitation>

- If you have any cold symptoms such as fever and coughing or digestive symptoms such as diarrheal and vomiting, please refrain from visiting the inpatient.
- Check in at the security center in the main building (1F) and visit the ward staff station wearing a visitor ID.
- Please refrain from bringing any plant, including real flowers.
- · Visitors are not allowed to eat and drink at the patient room, day room, and dining hall.
- For visiting an inpatient admitted to non-general ward areas (i.e., ICU, CCU, EICU, HCU, NICU, GCU, ER, or 3A), please check the status at the staff station.
- For visitation outside the visiting hours, please consult the ward nursing staff by the day before.
- For infection control and safety's sake, the center normally does not accept visitation by children under the age of 12. However, if circumstances require, please consult the ward nursing staff.
- · Please be advised that additional limitations on visitation may be imposed depending on the status of infection spread.
